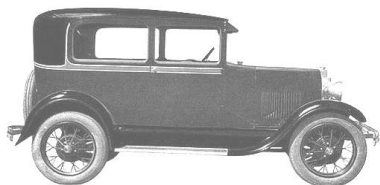

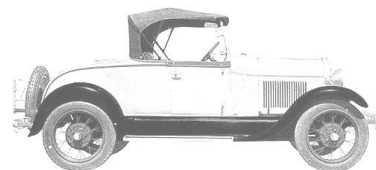

Temecula Valley A's – General Meeting – February 21, 2013

Meeting called to order at 7:00pm by President Robert Saxman

Pledge of Allegiance: Led by Karen Beel


