Apple Pie Bubble Up serves 8

- 1 (12-oz) can Pillsbury Grands Jr biscuits (10 count)
- 1 (21-oz) can apple pie filling
- 1 tsp cinnamon
- 1 cup butterscotch chips
- 1/2 cup powdered sugar

• 1 Tbsp milk Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Lightly spray a 9x13-inch pan with cooking spray. In a large bowl combine apple pie filling, cinnamon and butterscotch chips. Using a spatula, chop up apple slices into bite-sized pieces. Cut biscuits into 4 pieces. Stir into apple mixture. Pour into prepared pan and bake 25-30 minutes. Combine powdered sugar and milk. 
