Temecula Valley A's - General Meeting - November 20, 2014

Meeting called to order at 7:00 pm

Pledge of Allegiance led by Sheila Saxman

<u>President:</u> Karen Beel: Karen started the meeting by reminding everyone that the club dues of \$15 are due, give your money to Ted Iverson. 
The meeting adjourned at 8:11 p.m.


