Newsletter: Robert Saxman: Bob asked for pictures and articles for the newsletter.

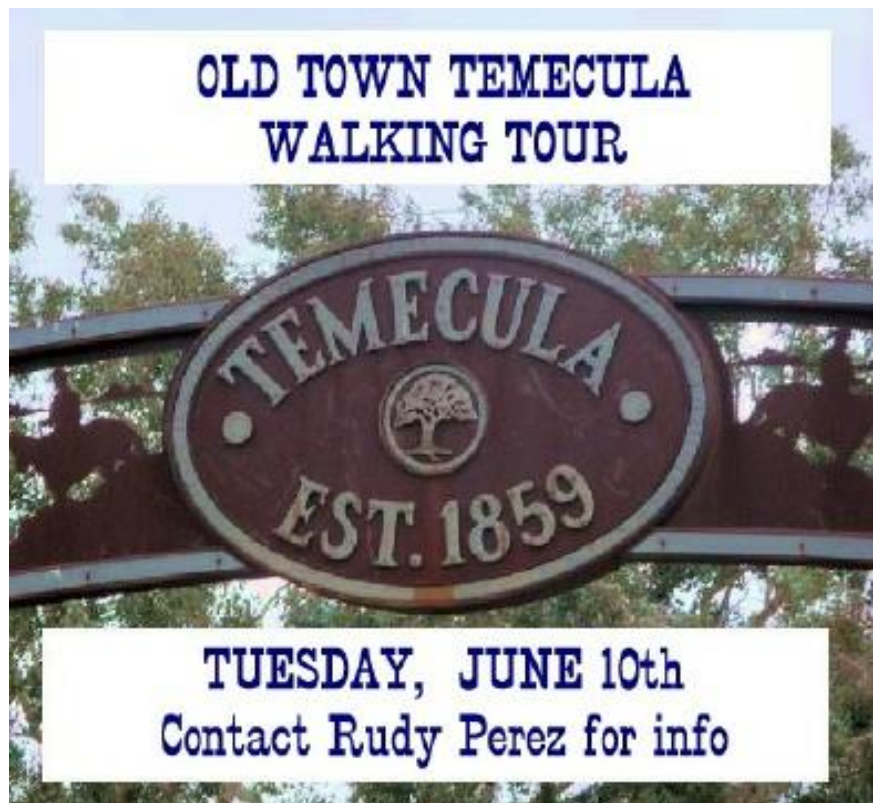
Historian: Historian needed.



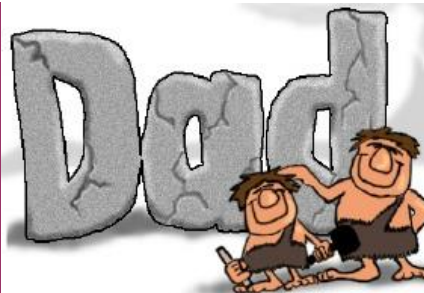
